

In general, the Chairman will allow an individual two minutes to address the Council. A spokesman, recognized as representing a group in attendance, may be allowed up to five minutes. At the conclusion of the Citizen Comment time, the Chairman may direct staff to assist the citizen on the issue presented; direct the citizen to the proper administrative department(s); or take no action. This policy also applies to all Public Hearings.

Citizens may also submit written requests (outlining their issue) for an item to be considered at a future Council meeting. The chairman may place the item on the agenda under Citizen Comments; direct staff to assist the citizen; direct the citizen to the proper administrative departments; or take no action.
