“Finely tuned,” is the best way to describe the recipient of this month’s *Best of Taylorsville* award. The home of Russ and Luedon Rogers, 2110 Quailstone Drive, is groomed and primmed and certainly attention getting, even in a neighborhood that appears to take great pride in its appearance.

The Rogers have been particular about landscaping and yard care since they moved into their new home in 1977. Hundreds of annuals and perennials later, they continue to try new combinations of shrubs and flowers that keep the property fresh and inviting. For the past 10 years, they have nursed finely trimmed rows of boxwood and euonymus that border the property on the sides and front of the house. The deep green barrier serves as a contrasting backdrop for vibrant, billowy mounds of petunia and vinca. It all surrounds a lawn lush enough to resemble the finest outdoor carpet.

Such a setting doesn’t happen without effort, and the yard gets some form of care almost daily. Russ caches his grass clippings for use as a soil amendment in the fall. Luedon takes special charge of several flower pots that grace the property and has helped teach neighbors the art of potting. Both find that beautifying their home is therapeutic and satisfying. They hope their property helps express why Taylorsville is a great place to live.

For their efforts the Taylorsville City Council will present the Rogers with a beautiful plaque donated by Crown Trophy, and a basket of goodies from Great Harvest Bakery, both supportive Taylorsville businesses.
