In another life, Jeanne Anderson figures she was probably a farmer. That would explain why every growing thing in the Anderson yard looks like it's been planned and groomed for years. Their beautifully sculpted landscape at 5174 South 2595 West, wins the Andersons the *Best of Taylorsville* award for the month of October.

When Jeanne and her husband Lynn moved into their Taylorsville home 10 years ago, they began a long term plan to beautify their home. Jeanne is the real brains and brawn behind the landscape. Many of the strikingly diverse plants are allowed to die out each year so she can try something different the next. She works with zinnias, roses, geraniums, dahlias, petunias, Oregon grapes and lilacs, to name just a few. Perfectly plotted flower beds and a rock-walled backyard border contain unique flowers, ground cover and grasses not typically seen in local neighborhoods.

The Anderson's dark green lawn is flawlessly manicured. Lynn says he will often find Jeanne mowing right behind him just to make sure there isn't a blade out of place.

For their superb effort in beautifying their property and showing their Taylorsville pride, the Andersons will be honored at City Council meeting on November 5. They will receive a beautiful plaque donated by Crown Trophy and a basket of goodies from Great Harvest Bread Company; both are supportive Taylorsville businesses.
