**Answers to "Did You Know?" quiz:**

- 1) False. It is unlawful for any person to park on a street or highway for a consecutive period greater than 24 hours (Section 11.20.080).
- 2) False. It is not legal to deposit snow removed from a driveway or sidewalk into the street (Section 14.20.105). Additionally, moving snow from a driveway or sidewalk into the gutter is prohibited (Section 14.32.110).
- 3) True. Pet licenses are required for dogs, cats, and ferrets once the animal reaches 4 months of age. In the case of acquiring an animal over 4 months of age, residents have 30 days to obtain a license (Section 8.16.020).
