The construction season has started and Taylorsville will certainly have our share of torn up roads this year. Construction will occur in the intersections at 5400 South Redwood Road, 4700 South Redwood Road, 5400 South Bangerter Highway and 4700 South Bangerter Highway. Traffic patterns will be impacted and congestion will be increased during the construction periods. When the projects are completed, traffic will flow more efficiently and safely.

I encourage everyone to become familiar with the road projects that will likely impact them and to look for alternate routes or adjusted travel times. Links to UDOT are available on the City website (www.taylorsvilleut.gov). The links provide details as to project timelines and scope of work.

Businesses in Taylorsville will also be impacted by these projects. Please know that businesses in the construction zones are open for business and deserve and need our continued patronage. UDOT has committed to make access to businesses and residential areas as convenient as possible.
