

# Snow Removal & Parking

With winter nearing, and the inevitable snowfall that follows, please take a moment to review the City of Taylorsville's Snow Removal and Parking Ordinances.

By reviewing and more importantly adhering to the Snow Related Ordinances, it allows everyone from children walking to and from school, to snow plow drivers clearing your street, an opportunity to get where they need to go in a safe and timely manner.

## Snow Removal

It is unlawful for the owner, occupant, lessor or agent of property abutting on a paved sidewalk to fail to remove or cause to be removed from such paved sidewalk and any existing curb ramp all hail, snow or sleet falling thereon, within twenty four (24) hours after the hail, snow or sleet has ceased falling, provided that in case of a storm ending between the hours of 5:00 p.m. in the afternoon and 6:00 a.m. in the morning, the sidewalk and any existing curb ramp shall be cleaned before 8:00 a.m. the morning following the storm.



## Parking



It is unlawful for any person who owns or has possession, custody or control of any vehicle to park or knowingly allow to be parked any vehicle on any street after a snow accumulation of four inches (4") or more, until twenty four (24) hours after the end of such accumulation.

Remove all vehicles under your control from the City streets following fall of 4 inches or more. Vehicles which hamper snow removal are subject to impound without notice of the owner.
