City Youth Ambassadors have provided service to our community.

Kyra Holman, Lindsay Bell, Echo Ferrin, Lauren Gwilliam, and Natalie Noakes have completed their terms as City of Taylorsville Youth Ambassadors for 2008-2009. Kyra, Echo, and Natalie have also served as members of the Taylorsville Youth City Council.

In addition to participating in ribbon cuttings, various civic events, volunteering at Taylorsville Dayzz, and participating in the Taylorsville Dayzz Parade, Taylorsville Youth Ambassadors have been working on their individual service projects.

- **Kyra Holman**—*Helped with the Lupus Walk. She involved people in volunteering and donating.*
- **Lindsay Bell**—*Organized a Bike Rodeo at Vista Elementary School, assisted officers from Taylorsville City Police Department.*
- **Echo Ferrin**—*Centering on Children—Volunteered at the Children's Center, where she organized three service projects.*
- **Lauren Gwilliam**—*Organized a bake sale at the Sanderson Community Center, and raised more than \$6,000 to help a family with medical expenses.*
- **Natalie Noakes**—*Educated students at Calvin Smith Elementary in ways to be healthy, and encouraged them to start practicing good habits while they are young.*



Youth Ambassadors serve for a period of one year, chosen each September. Each ambassador can only serve one term. Youth Ambassadors are provided with a blazer with the City logo to identify them as Taylorsville youth representatives. Each ambassador will be awarded a \$750 scholarship to be used at any institution of higher learning which they choose.

Youth Ambassadors are chosen by a selection panel made up of the Mayor, one member of the City Council, one representative from a Taylorsville secondary school, one resident, and one member of a local service organization.

- Submit letters of recommendation (minimum two)—one must come from a representative of the school, or an employer—others can be from neighbors, friends, ecclesiastical leaders, etc.)
- Participate in oral interview by selection panel.
- Application will include a resume of previous extra-curricular activities.
