This month's exciting historic photo is of the UTOCO gas station which was located on the southeast corner of 4800 South and Redwood Road in Taylorsville, Utah. Behind the station can be seen the popular "Tripp In" restaurant where all the local teens gathered to enjoy sodas like the "Wild Indian" — a drink with all the flavors mixed together. This restaurant was later moved to 1207 West 4800 South in the 1940s.

The Mariscos Ensenada Restaurant is the restaurant now located on the southeast corner of Redwood Road at 4855 South.
