This month's exciting historic photo is of the Taylorsville Mercantile which was located on the west side of Redwood Road at 4860 South. Joseph and Samuel Lindsay started the business in 1894. This business sold a variety of items such as groceries, dry goods, and even Ford motorcars.

The business was later purchased by Joe Bennion, then Clyde and Abe Barker, and then the Pollard family until the building was torn down. The same location has housed an Albertsons, Frank's Barbershop, Zions Bank and other businesses. Family Store True Value is currently operating at this location.
