It all began on April 17, 1950 when ground was broken for the funeral home under the ownership of R. David McDougal and his wife Joyce Muir McDougal - the day they returned from their honeymoon. The formal opening of the home was held November 19, 1950, with two major additions having been made since that time. Later, Dave's brother Richard joined the funeral director team along with his wife Carolyn Coates McDougal. They have proudly been serving families using the "Golden Rule" motto of running the business for the past 60 years.
