So what is a Firework “Cake”?

A “Cake” is a 500 gram (or smaller) device that can shoot multiple shots from a single device that will not tip over when used.



An Example of a 500 gram Cake type firework




In Utah, legal fireworks are “pyrotechnic devices that are offered for sale in Utah only, by a licensed vendor and the fireworks have been approved for use.”

Safety Tips

- Only buy fireworks from a licensed store or stand
- Inform neighbors and be aware of their concerns
- Never allow children to light or use fireworks
- Have a hose, and a bucket of water ready if needed
- Never attempt to light a “Dud”
- Do not alter or “Double-Up” fireworks
- Do not use fireworks indoors, in a vehicle or under an awning
- Use fireworks only in areas that will not

The Rules Have Changed

Utah State Law has changed. This pamphlet is designed to assist you in understanding new laws pertaining to Consumer Fireworks.

The “NO GO” List Illegal in Utah are:

- Sky Rockets
- Missile Type Rockets
- Bottle Rockets
- Roman Candles
- Cannon Crackers
- Ground Salutes
- Firecrackers
- M-80, Cherry Bombs and Similar explosives
- A Single shot or Reloadable Aerial Shell
- All of the items listed above and any “Cakes” with more than 500 grams of pyrotechnic composition



New This Year

Cakes: Multiple tube devices that do not exceed 500 grams of powder, have only 1-fuse, a stable base and when lit go off in sequence are now allowed. Use caution, in that sparks will elevate several feet into the air. They are never to be used indoors, under or inside of any type of covering such as an awning, garage, or carport!

New Dates for Sale and Discharge of Fireworks

Only approved fireworks may be sold and safely used during the following dates each year:

June 26 through July 26
Dec. 26 through Jan. 1
Three days before and on the Chinese New Year

“Class C” common state approved fireworks must be sold in Utah by a licensed vendor. It is illegal to transport non-approved fire-
