

**CITY OF TAYLORSVILLE
2009 MUNICIPAL ELECTIONS**

The City of Taylorsville will hold a Municipal Election on November 3, 2009 to elect a Mayor and two City Council members to serve four-year terms. One nonpartisan candidate for Mayor shall be elected at-large and one nonpartisan candidate for City Council shall be elected from District 4 and from District 5. Given a sufficient number of candidates, a Primary Election will be held on September 15, 2009.

A person may become a candidate for any municipal office if:

- the person is a registered voter; and
- the person has resided within the municipality for 12 consecutive months immediately before the date of the election;
- each candidate for a municipal council position shall, if elected from a district, be a resident of the council district from which elected;
- In accordance with Utah Constitution Article IV, Section 6, any mentally incompetent person, any person convicted of a felony, or any person convicted of treason or a crime against the elective franchise may not hold office in this state until the right to hold elective office is restored.

Candidates must file with the City Recorder between July 1, 2009 and July 15, 2009 and a filing fee of \$35.00 must be paid at the time of filing the declaration of candidacy (office hours are Monday through Friday from 8:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m.).
