**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TAYLORSVILLE COUNCIL APPOINTING TEMPORARY
JUDGES TO THE TAYLORSVILLE JUSTICE COURT**

WHEREAS, the Taylorsville City Council (“*Council*”) met in regular session on April 6, 2011, to consider, among other things, appointing temporary judges to the Taylorsville Justice Court; and

WHEREAS, from time to time, the Taylorsville Justice Court requires the services of a temporary judge to fill a vacancy due to absence or disqualification of the permanent Justice Court judges; and

WHEREAS, UTAH CODE ANN. § 78A-7-208 grants authority to the appointing authority to appoint a temporary judge currently holding office within the same jurisdictional judicial district to serve as a temporary judge when the permanent judge is absent or disqualified; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor is the executive and pursuant to §78A-7-208 and Taylorsville Code of Ordinances §2.16 , has power to appoint and fill vacancies in all offices provided by the law with the advice and consent of the Council ; and

WHEREAS, the Council has given advice for the appointment of temporary Justice Court judges; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council that pursuant to UTAH CODE ANN. § 78A-7-202 and Taylorsville Code of Ordinances §2.16, the Council consents to the appointment of the following temporary Justice Court judges:

1. Judge Farr
2. Judge Bown
3. Judge Magid
4. Any other active or senior active Justice Court judge residing in Salt Lake County or any adjoining county

This Ordinance, assigned No. 11-06, shall take effect immediately upon passage and acceptance as provided herein.
