The Administrative Enforcement Hearing Officer acts in an official capacity, hearing code compliance issues that have not been resolved through courtesy letters and follow up activities by the City's Code Enforcement Officers. Hearings are conducted by the Administrative Enforcement Hearings Officer to allow property owners an opportunity to be heard on issues resulting from notices and/or citations issued by Taylorville Officers.

Two Attorneys are recommended for appointment in this Resolution to accommodate the occasional scheduling conflict or conflict of interest event. Both Attorneys have served or are currently serving the City in this capacity.

WHEREAS, the City has an Administrative Code Enforcement Ordinance that contemplates the service of an Administrative Enforcement Hearings Officer; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor hereby nominates Gregory J. Christiansen and Jeremy D. Eveland to serve as Administrative Enforcement Hearings Officers; and

WHEREAS, the Council has given advice with respect to the appointment; and

WHEREAS, after careful consideration, the Council has determined that it is in the best interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Taylorsville to consent to the appointment of Gregory J. Christiansen and Jeremy D. Eveland as Administrative Enforcement Hearings Officers.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council that Gregory J. Christiansen and Jeremy D. Eveland are appointed as Administrative Enforcement Hearings Officers for purposes of the City's Administrative Code Enforcement Ordinance.
