ISSUE SUMMARY:

The Taylorsville City Council noticed and held a public hearing on 04 December 2013, to hear public comment on the Administration's proposal to provide special funding through the CDBG program for the FY 2013-2014.

With the adoption of this Resolution, the City Council will allocate an additional \$66,763 from funds not disbursed as part of the adopted 2013-2014 FY Budget adoption in August 2013.

The distribution of these additional funds is as follows:

1. Senior Citizen Center Expansion Project -- \$63,813, and
2. Tri-Park Services to provide services to the Taylorsville Food Pantry -- \$2,950

**RESOLUTION APPROVING THE REALLOCATION OF FY 2013-2014
CDBG FUNDS
FOR
EXPANSION OF TAYLORSVILLE SENIOR CENTER
TRI-PARK SERVICES**

WHEREAS, the City of Taylorsville will allocate funds not disbursed in the FY 2013-2014 CDBG Program. These funds will be allocated from the Contingency Fund. The amount to be allocated is \$66,763. These funds are allocated to Tri-Park Services \$2,950 and Senior Center Expansion \$63,813.

WHEREAS, the City of Taylorsville received more CDBG Funds than were originally programmed for the FY 2013-2014 year. Those funds went directly to Contingency and are now being allocated to programs.

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the people of Taylorsville that the City program these funds to better serve the needs of the community; and

WHEREAS, the City Council does meet now this Wednesday December 18, 2013 to approve the programming of FY 2013-2014 CDBG funds.

WHEREAS, the public notices, hearings and other pre-submission requirements as set forth in 24 CFR Part 91 have been accomplished by the City, including but not limited to the following: A public hearing held Wednesday, December 4, 2013 to consider the proposed programming of the additional CDBG funds, and to obtain views of citizens regarding the allocation of funds

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of Taylorsville, Utah as follows:

1. That the Mayor, as the official representative of Taylorsville, is hereby authorized to amend the City's One Year Action Plan.
