**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF TAYLORSVILLE ADVISING AND CONSENTING
TO THE MAYOR'S APPOINTMENT OF A CHIEF BUILDING OFFICIAL FOR THE
CITY OF TAYLORSVILLE**

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the City of Taylorsville to have the assistance of a Chief Building Official to perform and/or oversee acts and duties requiring specific knowledge and/or certification relating to building and construction compliance with State and local codes and rules, and to provide professional advice regarding structure planning, construction, renovation, and maintenance practices of the City and its citizens; and

WHEREAS, the Taylorsville City Council met in regular meeting on September 17, 2014, to consider, among other things, approving a resolution advising and consenting to the Mayor's appointment of a Chief Building Official for the City of Taylorsville; and

WHEREAS, under the Council-Mayor form of municipal government adopted and under current use by the City, the Mayor may, as the City's Chief Executive Officer and pursuant to Utah Code Ann. §10-3b-202, appoint, with the City Council's advice and consent, a Chief Building Official, that office being the office of a department head; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor has found that Steve Porten has the necessary skills, qualifications, experience, and credentials to perform the duties of Chief Building Official, and therefore desires to appoint Steve Porten to that office; and

WHEREAS, the Taylorsville City Council hereby also finds that Steve Porten has the qualifications necessary to be the Chief Building Official; and

WHEREAS, the Council has given advice for such appointment and hereby consents to such appointment; and

WHEREAS, after careful consideration the Council has determined that it is in the best interest of the citizens of the City to consent to such appointment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Taylorsville City Council as follows:

That the Taylorsville City Council hereby consents to the Mayor's appointment of Steve Porten as the Chief Building Official for the City of Taylorsville.

This Resolution, assigned Resolution No. 14-26, will take effect as soon as it is published or posted as required by law, deposited, and recorded in the office of the City Recorder.
