**RESOLUTION NO. 15-14**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF TAYLORSVILLE APPROVING THE 2015  
MUNICIPAL VOTING PRECINCTS AND POLLING PLACES FOR  
TAYLORSVILLE, UTAH**

**WHEREAS**, the Taylorsville City Council (“Council”) met in regular meeting on June 3, 2015, to consider, among other things, approving the 2015 municipal voting precincts and polling places for the City of Taylorsville, Utah (“City”); and

**WHEREAS**, UTAH CODE ANN. § 20A-5-403(1) provides, among other things, that the election officer shall obtain approval of the City’s legislative body for designating polling places for each voting precinct; and

**WHEREAS**, UTAH CODE ANN. § 20A-5-301 (2a) provides that the Council may combine two or more regular county voting precincts into one municipal voting precinct if they designate the location and address of each precinct; and

**WHEREAS**, the Utah State Code also provides that, if only two precincts are combined, the polling place shall be within the combined precinct or within one-half mile of the boundaries of the combined voting precinct; and

**WHEREAS**, the Utah State Code further provides that, if more than two precincts are combined, the polling place should be as near as practical to the middle of the combined precinct; and

**WHEREAS**, the Council understands that some polling places may change from time to time; and

**WHEREAS**, the Council has determined that it is in the best interests of the inhabitants of the City to establish the 2015 municipal voting precincts and polling places for the City.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council that the list attached hereto designating polling places for each voting precinct is hereby approved and that such list may be modified from time to time by the election officer for unforeseen circumstances, provided such changed polling places satisfy the requirements of state statute.

This Resolution, assigned Resolution No. 15-14, shall take effect immediately upon passage and acceptance as provided herein.
