ISSUE SUMMARY: The Federal Emergency Management Agency initiated the Emergency Management Performance Grant program to assist state, local, territorial and tribal governments in preparing for hazards by providing necessary direction, coordination, guidance and assistance to support a comprehensive all-hazards emergency preparedness system at the federal, state and political subdivision levels. The EMPA program has allocated a grant for the City of Taylorsville in the amount of \$17,500.00 to be used for emergency preparedness related items such as salary, benefits, supplies, travel and other items noted in the EMPG guidance book.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION: Staff recommends that the City Council approve Resolution No. 15-24 accepting the EMPA grant funds.

**A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING AN EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT
PERFORMANCE GRANT FROM THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF
HOMELAND SECURITY FEDERAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY
AS DISTRIBUTED BY THE UTAH DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY FOR
THE 2015 FISCAL YEAR**

WHEREAS, the Taylorsville City Council (the “Council”) met in regular session on August 19, 2015, to consider, among other things, accepting an Emergency Management Performance Grant from the United States Department of Homeland Security Federal Emergency Management Agency as distributed by the Utah Department of Public Safety for the 2015 fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, the Emergency Management Performance Grant Program (“EMPG”) is a federal program funded by the United States Department of Homeland Security Federal Emergency Management Agency; and

WHEREAS, The purpose of the EMPG program is to provide federal grant funds to states to assist state, local, territorial and tribal governments in preparing for hazards by providing necessary direction, coordination, guidance and assistance to support a comprehensive all-hazards emergency preparedness system at the federal, state, and political subdivision levels; and

WHEREAS, the City’s allocation of EMPG funds for the 2015 fiscal year amounts to \$17,500 and covers the period of January 1, 2015 to December 31, 2015; and

WHEREAS, the City’s allocation of EMPG funds may be used to assist in covering some of the expenses necessary for the City’s local emergency management programs, including salary, benefits, supplies, travel and other items noted in the EMPG guidance book.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Taylorsville City Council that the EMPG funds for the 2015 fiscal year are hereby accepted.

This resolution, assigned Resolution No. 15-24, shall take effect immediately upon passage and acceptance as provided herein.
