**APPROPRIATION RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE ONE YEAR ACTION PLAN FOR
39TH YEAR COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT FUNDING,
HOME INVESTMENT PARTNERSHIP FUNDING
(2013-2014)
AND APPROVING INTERLOCAL COOPERATION AGREEMENT
BETWEEN THE CITY OF TAYLORSVILLE AND
THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT**

WHEREAS, the City of Taylorsville is entitled under 24 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) Part 91, et al., to receive Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds in the amount of \$323,000 and HOME Investment Partnerships Program (HOME) funds in the amount of \$70,000 from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development for the program year 2013-2014; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the people of Taylorsville that the City file an application with HUD for said funds in accordance with 24 CFR Part 91; and

WHEREAS, the public notices, hearings and other pre-submission requirements as set forth in 24 CFR Part 91 have been accomplished by the City, including but not limited to the following: A public hearing held Wednesday, March 6, 2013 to consider the proposed list of CDBG and HOME projects requesting funding, and to obtain views of citizens regarding the City's One Year Action Plan;

WHEREAS, the City Council does meet now this March 13, 2013 to adopt the City's Final One-Year Action Plan for CDBG and HOME.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of Taylorsville, Utah as follows:

1. That the City of Taylorsville hereby adopts its Final One Year Action Plan for CDBG, HOME as set forth in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and made a part hereof by this reference.
2. That the Mayor, as the official representative of Taylorsville, is hereby authorized to submit the City's Final One Year Action Plan for CDBG and HOME funds together with additional information and certifications as may be required under 24 CFR Part 91 to the U. S. Department of Housing and Urban Development.
3. That the Mayor, as the official representative of Taylorsville, is hereby authorized to sign and execute the HUD Grant Agreement and any and all subsequent agreements between the City and other public entities resulting from and consistent with the HUD Grant Agreement, subject to final approval as to form by the City Attorney.
