

Autumn Meadow Park

- 5300 South 2200 West, Taylorsville
- .77 acre grassed retention basin with no amenities
- Owned by City of Taylorsville

Azure Meadows Park

- 6070 South 3885 West, Taylorsville
- .41 acre neighborhood park with minimal grass area, pavilion, and a playground.
- Owned by City of Taylorsville

Bennion Park

- 5600 South 3200 West, Taylorsville
- 4.15 acre grassed neighborhood retention basin with a playground.
- Owned by City of Taylorsville

Forty-eighth (48th) Street Trailhead

- 4800 South 580 West, Murray
- 1.77 acre trailhead with picnic tables and benches. Adjacent to the [Jordan River Parkway](#).
- Owned by Salt Lake County

Freedom Shrine

- 612 West Taylorsville Expressway (4500 South)
- Owned by City of Taylorsville, no amenities

Jordan River Parkway Trail

- A system of trails that runs parallel to the Jordan River from the Utah County line to the Great Salt Lake
- Salt Lake County maintains the following adjacent trailheads: Jordan Narrows (17000 South 1200 West), Springview Farms (14600 South 1150 West), Forty-Eighth Street (4800 South 580 West), Holm (1050 West 3800 South), Oxbow (3300 South 1100 West), Redwood Nature Area (2660 South 1160 West) and Jordan River Trailhead (2320 South 1000 West).

Jordan River Reserve

- 4880 South 850 West, Taylorsville
- 10.4 acres of undeveloped open space owned by the State of Utah, no amenities

Little Confluence Trailhead

- 4800 South 677 West, Taylorsville
- 9.06 acre open space under development with potential pavilions, walking trails, and boat pull-out area.

Millrace Park (reservable)

- 5400 South 1150 West, Taylorsville
- A 23.2 acre park with 2 pavilions, informal baseball field, soccer and/or football area, 1 playground, walking trail, restrooms, community fishing pond, and a fenced off-leash dog park (permit required).
- Owned by City of Taylorsville

Southridge Park (reservable)

- 5051 South 4015 West, Taylorsville
- A large 39.8 acre community park with a wide range of amenities including: 5 baseball fields, basketball courts, volleyball, cricket, soccer, rugby, and tennis courts. 1 playground, 1 pavilion, and restrooms.
- Owned by Salt Lake County.

Taylorsville Park (North End)

- 4721 South 1700 West (Redwood Road), Taylorsville
- 6.96 acre community park with many trees, amenities and an open grassy area. A reservable pavilion and a skateboard park are located at the south end.
- Owned by City of Taylorsville

Taylorsville Park (South End) (reservable)

- 4751 South Plymouth View Drive (1625 West), Taylorsville
- 3.97 acre community park with many trees and amenities, including a skateboard park, a reservable pavilion and a large, open grassy area.
- Owned by Salt Lake County

Rocky Mountain Power Corridor Trail Head

- 925 West 4800 South, Taylorsville
- Parking lot with trail head to 9.20 acres of Jordan River Parkway
- Owned by Rocky Mountain Power

Valley Regional Park (reservable)

- 5100 South 2700 West, Taylorsville
- 91.40 acre regional park with a pavilion, playground, disc golf course, paved trail, outdoor basketball complex, 4-field softball complex, 2 sand volleyball courts, large grass areas, [pool](#) and [library](#).
- Owned by Salt Lake County

Vista Baseball Complex

- 4993 South 2200 West, Taylorsville
- 5 fields used by the City of Taylorsville Little League and adjacent to the County's softball complex.
- 15.15 acres owned by City of Taylorsville and Salt Lake County

Vista Softball Complex

- 4900 South 1950 West
- 4 Softball fields with walking trail around perimeter
- 7.63 acres, owned by Salt Lake County

Vista Park (reservable)

- 2051 West 5000 South
- Pavilion, playground, restrooms, and walking trail
- 9.6 acres, owned by City of Taylorsville
