## What does it mean for you?

As a resident of Taylorsville, there are many ways that you will benefit from a designated Taylorsville ZIP code.

- Friends and family can find your home using online map searches
- Sales taxes that belongs to Taylorsville will be properly received by the City in a timely manner
- Property values are more accurately represented
- Taylorsville City can appropriately apply for federal grants based on accurate demographic information of city residents
- Businesses within city limits can market their business as a Taylorsville business
- City services are not confused across city boundaries because of ZIP codes

## ZIP codes aren't just mail delivery.

While many people associate ZIP codes with birthday cards and utility bills, there is more to a ZIP code than delivering mail. ZIP codes determine the allocation of sales and property taxes, affect the ability to collect federal grants, help establish real estate values, and bring recognition to the city of the given ZIP code.

There are four ZIP codes that are used within the city limits of Taylorsville, but not a single one of those are directly identified as a Taylorsville ZIP code.
