**A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING A ZOO, ARTS AND PARKS GRANT FROM SALT LAKE COUNTY IN THE AMOUNT OF \$4,500 TO FUND THE TAYLORSVILLE BENNION HERITAGE CENTER**

**WHEREAS**, the Taylorsville City Council (the “Council”) met in regular session on October 21, 2020, to consider, among other things, accepting a Zoo, Arts, and Parks Grant from Salt Lake County to fund the Taylorsville Bennion Heritage Center; and

**WHEREAS**, TAYLORSVILLE MUNICIPAL CODE § 2.32.180 provides that any grant that anticipates or proposes to bind the City to a particular project or contract shall be submitted to the Council for approval prior to accepting the grant; and

**WHEREAS**, the City has received notice from Salt Lake County that the above referenced grant has been awarded to the Historic Preservation Committee to fund the Taylorsville Bennion Heritage Center; and

**WHEREAS**, the purpose for the grant is to provide funds for elementary school bus transportation to the Taylorsville Bennion Heritage Center; and

**WHEREAS**, after careful consideration, the Council has determined that it is in the best interests of the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the City to accept this grant from Salt Lake County/Zoo, Arts and Parks.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Taylorsville City Council hereby accepts the \$4,500 grant for the above-stated purpose and directs the City Administrator to include this amount in the 2020-2021 Mid-Year or Year-End Budget Adjustments, increasing both revenue and corresponding expenditure lines.

This Resolution, assigned Resolution No. 20-40, shall take effect immediately upon passage and acceptance as provided herein.
