



**A PROCLAMATION BY THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF TAYLORSVILLE  
DECLARING STATE OF LOCAL EMERGENCY AND INVOKING EMERGENCY  
POWERS.**

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**WHEREAS**, pursuant to UTAH CODE ANN. §§53-2A-205 AND 208, the Mayor has the authority to declare a local state of emergency for the City of Taylorsville; and

**WHEREAS**, once the Mayor has declared a local state of emergency, the Mayor is authorized to invoke certain powers in aid of responding to and mitigating such state of emergency; and

**WHEREAS**, in recent months, the global community has been and continues to experience the unprecedented rapid spread of COVID-19, a virus for which there currently is no vaccine or treatment for, and which appears to be highly contagious; and

**WHEREAS**, the rapid spread of COVID-19 presents a very real threat to public health, safety, and welfare, potentially endangering a majority of the City's population; and

**WHEREAS**, COVID-19 currently potentially threatens all areas within the boundaries of the City of Taylorsville; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to executive order signed by Utah Governor Gary R. Herbert on March 6, 2020, the State of Utah declared a state of emergency in Utah due to the global outbreak of COVID-19; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to the proclamation signed by Salt Lake County Mayor Jennifer Wilson on March 6, 2020, Salt Lake County also declared a county state of emergency due to the global outbreak of coronavirus; and

**WHEREAS**, these conditions create a state of emergency according to the laws of the State of Utah.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED** by the Taylorsville City Mayor that:

1. A local state of emergency exists for the City of Taylorsville due to COVID-19;
2. The emergency powers, authorities, and operations of the City are hereby invoked to perform all functions authorized by the laws of the United States of America, the laws

of the State of Utah, the ordinances of Salt Lake County, and the ordinances of the City of Taylorsville;

3. This declaration shall take effect immediately and shall be declared to be ongoing and continuing for no more than thirty (30) days until terminated or extended pursuant to governing law;
4. The City is authorized to request all assistance available to the City of Taylorsville pursuant to the laws of the United States of America, the laws of the State of Utah, the ordinances of Salt Lake County, and the ordinances of the City of Taylorsville, and to activate all applicable mutual aid agreements;
5. This declaration shall be filed promptly with the Office of the Clerk of the City, which is the City Recorder.
