DUE TO ORDERS ISSUED BY THE UTAH JUDICIAL COUNCIL, SALT LAKE COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENT AND THE SALT LAKE COUNTY MAYOR, THE COURT HAS ORDERED THAT:

- 1. ALL COURT CASES HAVE BEEN RESCHEDULED.**
2. PUBLIC ACCESS TO THE COURT IS RESTRICTED DUE TO THE RISK OF INFECTION.
3. NO MORE THAN A TOTAL OF TEN (10) PEOPLE WILL BE ALLOWED IN THE COURTROOM AT A TIME.
 - a. Priority will be given to litigants, their attorneys and witnesses.
 - b. Individuals shall maintain the **best possible safe distance** from each other (Social Distancing is recommended).
4. Individuals with illness symptoms will be rescheduled or, if not possible, shall be required to wear personal protection equipment.
 - a. Personal protection equipment shall be discarded and replaced at least every two hours.
5. Court staff shall be required to wear personal protection equipment as recommended by the CDC.
6. Courtroom furniture, fixtures and equipment will be cleaned and disinfected between uses.
7. Extensions of deadlines for probation or plea-in-abeyance terms can be granted by calling or emailing the court.
8. Counsel are encouraged to stipulate to continuances.
9. Filings may be efiled, faxed, emailed or left at the Court's drop box on the south side of the building.
